All athletes must be 2024 members of USA Track & Field to participate.

- **NOTE: Multi-year membership discounts are available—check online.**
 - BEST OPTION: If you do not already have a 2024 membership you are encouraged to join on line at **USATF CONNECT**. Choose “Join Now.” You will need a VISA credit card to join on line. When joining on line, you will be given your membership number instantly. **Please print and bring with you your confirmation.**
 - **Membership can also be purchased at the meet before the close of packet pickup at 11:00 a.m.**
 - Cash payments.
 - Credit card payments for membership only will be accepted on meet day.
- **PLEASE MAKE SURE TO BRING IDENTIFICATION (Copy of birth certificate or passport OR membership card with birth date “verified”)**

MEET NOTES: Pyramid SPIKES only (1/4” or less)

RUNNING / WALKING events:

- Most events will be contested older to younger, women first.
- **AGE GROUPS** will be combined in some events if entries warrant.
- **Hurdle heights** will follow USATF or USATF Masters rules according to the division.
- An interest in **RELAYS** has been expressed, so will try the 4 x 100m and / or 4 x 400m relays. Registration at meet.

FIELD EVENTS:

AGE GROUPS will be combined in some events if entries warrant.

EXCUSED COMPETITOR: Please check in at each event and check out with the official if you have to leave an event.

Get instructions for returning. You may request a turn out of order to facilitate running.

- POLE VAULT and HIGH JUMP will start at a low height and move upward with all groups (men and women) combined. The bar will NOT be lowered after event begins. In any event, if you miss your call, you forfeit that attempt. ▪ LONG JUMP will be contested “Open Pit” It will begin from 9:00a.m. (Based on last year’s participation.) ▪ TRIPLE JUMP will follow the long jump.
- JAVELIN will be contested on grass.
- ALL IMPLEMENTS for warm-up and competition **must be checked in for certification at WEIGHTS & MEASURES in the registration area from 8:30 to 9:00 a.m.** ○ Implement weights according to the USATF and USATF Masters rules. ○ Remember: In the Masters competition, privately owned implements are exempt from the loss of identity rule. You must ask if you are borrowing.

IMPLEMENTS: **All Athletes Must Provide Their Own Implements.** **THROWS schedule begins at 10:00 a.m. (See page 1)**

- **NOTE: You must provide your own weights.**

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- **Throws Pentathlon: Contested only if we have enough Officials.**
- **Super Weight: Contested only if we have enough Officials**

AWARDS:

Age Groups are defined on the application. Non-Michigan athletes will not displace Michigan athletes.

Top 3 Michigan athletes in each group will receive medals. Non-Michigan athletes in the top 3 will receive similar medals. ▪

Medals will not be mailed. Please pick them up at the awards area before you leave. Thanks.
